## Where to call about wind storm recovery concerns

(Camp Murray, Wash.)—People affected by last week’s winter wind storm will have many questions about recovery—where to find shelter if they are still without power, where to haul debris from their property, who will clean up debris on streets and roads. A good place to go for answers is the emergency management agency in the county where they live. County emergency management agencies have established phone numbers and some have web sites. Web sites are not offered in the chart below, but should be easily located with an Internet search engine. Callers should be able to talk to a person or leave a message at the numbers below. Remember, calls to 9-1-1 are for life-threatening police, fire or medical emergencies only.
